### **Important Revisions to the NSAID Medication Guide**

According to MedWatch, modifications have been made to the NSAID Medication Guide for Oruvail® and Orudis®. The revised NSAID Medication Guide includes a table detailing NSAID medicines that require a prescription. This table now includes Vicoprofen and states that Vicoprofen contains the same dose of ibuprofen as over-the-counter (OTC) NSAID, and is usually used for less than 10 days to treat pain. The OTC NSAID label warns that long term continuous use may increase the risk of heart attack or stroke.
